

## 2022 DOUBLE S ARENA SHOWS SERIES RULES

1. Double S Arena Show Series producers has the final say on all ruling(s).
2. No dress code except western heeled boots and long pants at Double S Arena Wednesday Barrel Series.
3. Exhibitions will be limited to 1 minute. If rider exceeds the one minute time limit, he/she will forfeit any additional exhibitions. Exhibitions are on the honor system, please be respectful of other riders.
4. Classes will be run in the following order: Open 1, Youth 1, Peewee1, Peewee 2, Open 2, Youth 2.
5. Late entries will be run at the end of each class. Entries will be accepted until the first rider of each class.
6. During competition the sorting pens to the North will be available to warm up in.
7. If you are carrying over your time you must indicate on the sign up form before the jackpot starts. Failure to do so will result in not carrying over your time.
8. If you are carrying over your time you will not be able to run. If you run that is your time.
9. Carry overs from Open 1 to Youth 1, Open 2 and Youth 2, are permitted.
10. Contestants will be allowed to mount in the arena.
11. A "leader horse" may be used to assist contestants through the gate. Contestant may not start their run until the "leader horse" has exited the arena.
12. The gate will be left open unless asked to be closed.
13. Rider must maintain forward motion after they cross the timeline.
14. Open class entry fee is \$20 per horse and will be paid out at 75% on the 4D 1/2 second split format (winner, +1/2, +1, +1 ½)
15. Youth (18 and under as of 1/1/21) class entry fee is \$10 per horse and will be paid out at 75% on the 3D 1 second split format (winner, +1, +2) Youth riders have the option of carrying their times.
16. Pee Wee (10 and under as of 1/1/21) class entry fee \$5 per horse.
17. Futurity and senior entry must be indicated on the sign up form.
18. Tipped barrels in the open and youth class will result in a no time. Tipped barrels in Peewee with result in a 5 second penalty.
19. A horse may not be ridden more than once in any given class.
20. A contestant will be disqualified for running the wrong horse. It is the contestant's responsibility to know their draw position. Rider changes must be reported to the show office prior to their run. Rider changes not reported to show office prior to run will result in a disqualification.
21. All reruns will be at the discretion of the Show Producer. Show Producer decisions are FINAL.
22. In the case of a timer malfunction rider will be offered a rerun.
23. We will drag every five riders for barrels.
24. Additional fees as follows:
  - \$10- Office fee per rider
  - \$4- Exhibition or 3 for \$10
25. Riders must compete in 18 of 22 jackpots to be eligible for the overall summer series high point buckles.
26. There will be an overall highpoint champion and res-champion for all the Divisions in Open and Youth.

*Unsportsmanlike conduct to horses, other competitors, workers, vendors, sponsors, or to production staff may result in immediate dismissal and forfeit of entry fees and any money earned.*
